Anti-ragging Rules:

- i. We are guided by the University Grants Commission advocated guidelines for curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions (Regulation – 2013). Student- Teachers are required to adhere to the anti-ragging rules that are in force in the campus.
- ii. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate this rule.

Punishment Measures Against the Act of Ragging:

Anti-ragging Committee: This committee shall examine all complain of anti-ragging and come out with recommendation based on the nature of the incident and proper investigation. If a student-teacher or group of student-teachers found guilty by the anti-ragging committee will attract one or more of the following punitory action by the college authority:

- a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- b) Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- c) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- d) Withholding results.
- e) If need be, in view of the intensity of the act of ragging committed, a First Information Report (FIR) shall be filed by the Institute with the local police authorities. The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institute shall take appropriate decision, including imposition of punishment, depending on the facts and circumstances of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.
